Qualifications: 1) Overseas researchers who have more than five years of experience in R&D outside of Korea after obtaining a Ph.D. or 2) who have more than five years of on-site R&D experiences regardless of a doctoral degree

- Funding: \$4,500~22,500/Month
 - (KRW 5 mil. ~ KRW 25mil. /Month.) including personnel expenses, Invitation Expenses, Living Expenses(funded by YFL)
- Period: 6~12 months or 3 years(2+1)
- Preference fields: As follows

Brain Pool Plus Program

(해외고급과학자초빙사업 Plus)

- Qualifications: Overseas researchers in new industries
 who will be hired as full-time (permanent) employees
 by host institutions in Korea
- Funding: Max. \$545,000/Year
 (Max. KRW 600 Mil. /Year) including personnel expenses, Invitation
- Period: Maximum 10 years (2+3+3+2)
- Target fields: As follows

Korea Research Fellowship

(해외 우수신진연구자 유치사업)

- Qualifications:

Overseas researchers who have within five years of experience in R&D outside of Korea after obtaining a Ph.D.

- Funding: Max. \$63,600 or 100,000/Year
 (Max. KRW 70 mil./year or KRW 110 mil./year) including
 Personnel expenses, Housing Allowance, Other, Subsidies for Host Institutions
- Period: 3~5 years
- Preference fields: Same as Brain Pool Program

Korea-Oceania Joint Research Program

(한-오세아니아 협력기반조성사업)

- Summary:

Perform joint research in areas favorable to the relationships between Korea-Australia and establish networks to improve understanding of S&T areas in each country

- Funding: Max. \$40,000/year

(Max. KRW 44 mil. /year) including direct costs and overhead costs incurred in conducting joint research

- Period: 2 years
- Target fields: IT, BT
- Note: Only Korean side can be funded by NRF
